

Vote online in the 2026 Municipal Election



EASY • SECURE • ACCESSIBLE

Cast your ballot online from October 16 to October 25. It's easy, secure, and accessible any time during the Voting Period. Follow the instructions below.

1 Check your mail for your Voter Information Letter.



2 Go online to aurora.ca/Voters and register.



To register online you will need the following:

- Name
- Date of Birth
- Voter ID Number (found on your Voter Information Letter)

Internet voting is available between October 16 and 25*. **There is NO internet voting on election day.**

3 Get your Voter PIN.

Have your unique Voter PIN emailed to you.

4 Vote Online.

Use your unique Voter PIN to obtain access to the voting site to mark your online ballot.

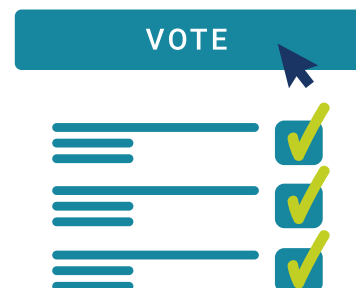

- ▶ Contact us if you see something suspicious, we are here to help
- ▶ Contact us immediately if you lost your Voter Information Letter or Voting PIN



- ▶ Never share your Voting PIN - it's unique to you. Municipal staff, candidates and law enforcement should never ask for it
- ▶ It's illegal to vote using a Voting PIN that is not yours
- ▶ You may only vote once in the Town of Aurora, no matter how many voting days there are or how many properties you own/rent
- ▶ Never post a photo or selfie with your ballot on social media or elsewhere - it's illegal
