- b) Repair all minor and major breakdown/damage resulting from operations.
- c) Maintain a clean and safe work environment including work areas, garage floor, store area and equipment.
- d) Maintain records of repairs including work orders, parts utilized, parts purchased, repair time, etc.
- e) Operate and test equipment following repairs/maintenance.
- f) Maintain and order stock, when required as well as maintain a parts and stock inventory control list.
- g) Participate in fleet management activities as required

Reporting directly to the Public Works Foreperson and Director of Public Services, and working with a team of excellent municipal staff, the successful applicant will be responsible for maintenance and repair of Town of Blind River equipment and its fleet of vehicles.

3. Construction Equipment Mechanic experience preferred
