- Make oral submissions at the Statutory Public Meeting of Council on October 6, 2026.

Want to be notified of the decision? If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Council of the Township of Bonfield on the proposed Official Plan, you must make a written request to the Clerk of the Corporation of the Township of Bonfield at the Township Municipal Office or by email to planning@bonfieldtownship.com.

Appeal rights. If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Council of the Township of Bonfield to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Bonfield before the proposed Official Plan is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

Party status. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Bonfield before the proposed Official Plan is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
