EVACUATION ORDER RESCIND (ALL CLEAR) Monday, August 17, 2026 at 5:30 PM

Pursuant to the BC Emergency and Disaster Management Act, the evacuation order issued on August 8, 2026, at 8:00 PM for the Palmer Creek Fire Area is being **rescinded to all clear** by Tsideldel First Nation, Tsilhqot'in National Government and the Cariboo Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).

An Evacuation Alert or Order may need to be reissued: however, if that is deemed necessary the process will re-commence.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO BEFORE RETURNING:

- Fill the gas tank of personal vehicles
- Bring a minimum of three days of food and essential supplies (e.g. medications, pet supplies) with you as local grocery stores may not yet have adequate stock

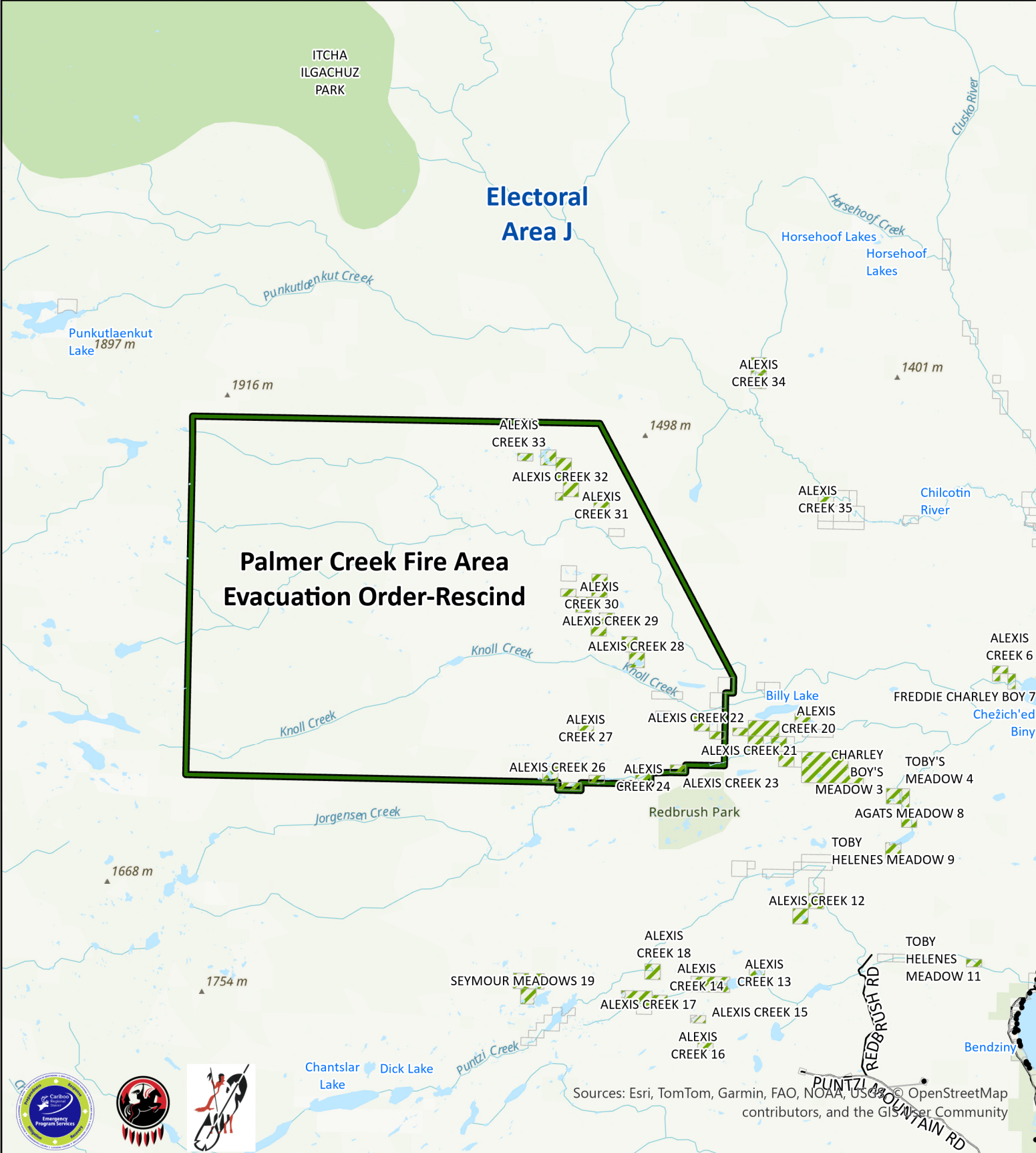

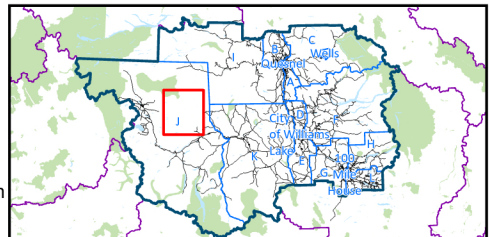
