Bonanza Creek Fire Area

PARTIAL EVACUATION ALERT LIFT

Friday, August 28, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.

The Evacuation Alert issued on July 22, 2026, at 8:00 p.m. for the Bonanza Creek Fire Area has been partially lifted for the western portion. Should conditions change, an Evacuation Alert and/or Evacuation Order will be reinstated as necessary.

An Evacuation Alert **remains in place for the eastern portion of the previous Alert area**. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

WHAT TO DO WHEN ON EVACUATION ALERT:

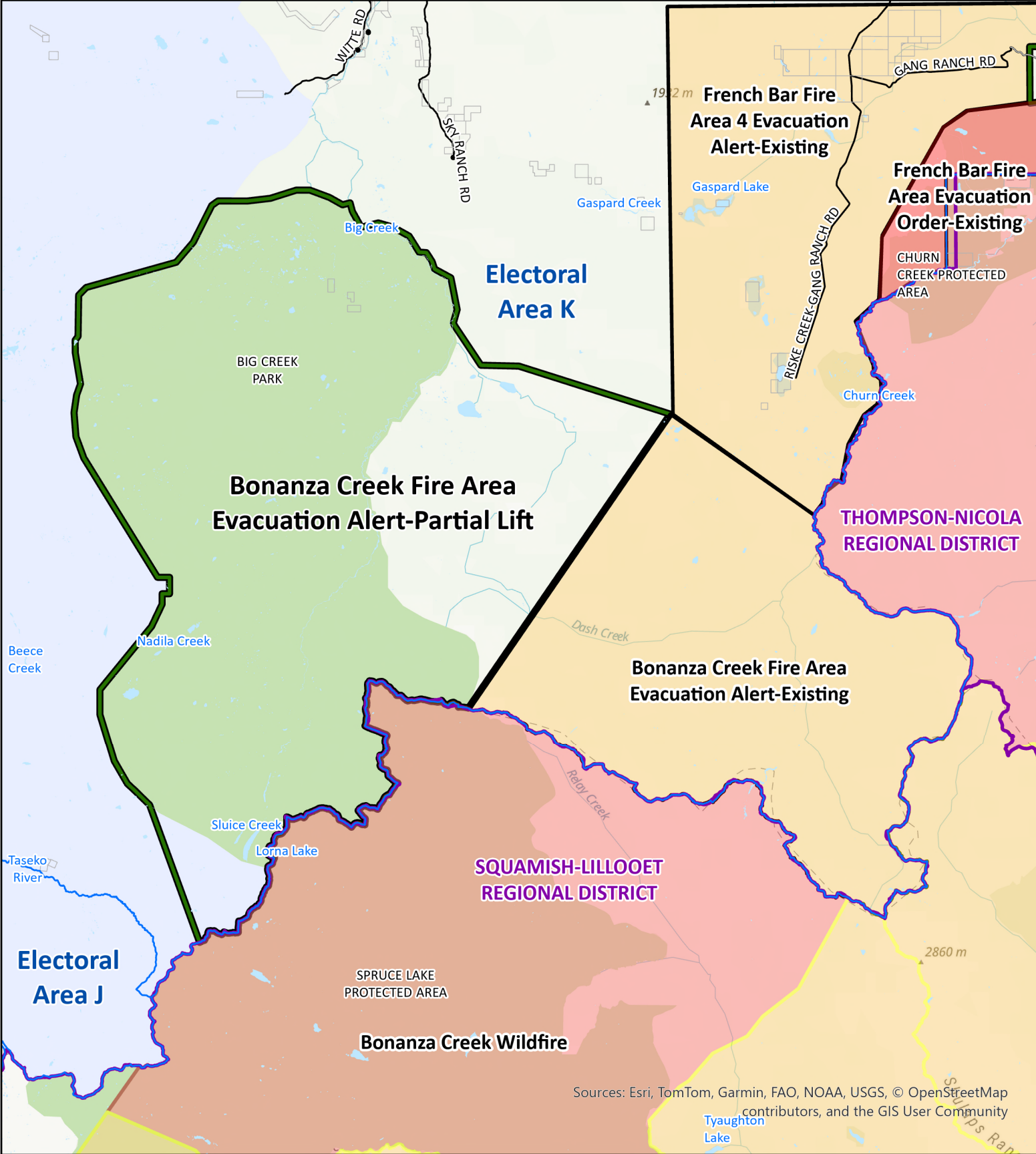
- Have a plan to transport all family members should the area be brought under evacuation order. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- Keep essential items such as medications, eyeglasses, government-issued ID, valuable documents, immediate care needs for dependents or pets and, if you choose, keepsakes, readily available for a quick departure.
- Register to receive emergency notifications through [Voyent Alert!](#)
- Check on friends and neighbours to see if they need assistance.
- Ensure that all dependents are prepared for departure.
- Prepare to move pets and livestock to a safe area.
- Arrange accommodation options for your family, if possible.
- Monitor reliable news sources for information on evacuation orders and locations of Reception Centers and the CRD's channels on Facebook and cariboord.ca/emergency
- Self-register for Emergency Support Services on the Evacuee Registration & Assistance (ERA) tool at <https://ess.gov.bc.ca/>
