



## Weekly Construction Update - Rebuilding Downtown Infrastructure Project

Date: Tuesday, September 1, 2026

### Phase 4: No vehicle access between East St. and North St.

To maximize travel distance around the Courthouse Square, enter via North St. and follow Detour 3 when approaching downtown in a vehicle. Last exit before construction fencing is East St.

FREE PARKING: Access two separate lots via Lighthouse St. and Kingston St. (also Stanley St.)

### Project Summary

#### This week:

- Sidewalks are now complete between East St. and North St. (Phase 4).
- Pre-case planters are being set and will be finished by the end of this week.
- Road grading will be completed in preparation for road paving.

#### Upcoming weeks:

- Road paving will be completed following the Labour Day weekend (September 8/9).
- LED lighting will be installed to illuminate planters throughout all phases.
- Final landscape plantings and replacement of Scarlet Oak trees in Phase 1 & 2.

#### Vehicular Access Update:

- Entrance ONLY onto the Courthouse Square from North St.
- No entrance to the Courthouse Square via East St. or Hamilton St.
- Exit ONLY from the Courthouse Square onto East St.

### Key Information

- Active construction Monday to Friday 7 AM to 6 PM.
- Sidewalks are open in front of businesses and the inner Courthouse Square.
- Driving around the Courthouse Square remains in one direction: Counterclockwise.
- RIGHT TURN ONLY when entering and exiting the traffic circle.

### Pedestrian Navigation

- ALL businesses are OPEN with regular operating hours.
- Sidewalks are accessible on the outer and inner side of the Courthouse Square.
- Pedestrian crossings to the interior of the Courthouse Square are located at North St., Colborne St., West St., Montreal St., South St., Kingston St. and East St.



## Parking

- Open: North St. around the Courthouse Square to East St.
- Closed: No parking from East St. and North St. on the Courthouse Square.
- See map below for FREE PARKING locations at the Kingston St. and Stanley St. intersection, and where Lighthouse St. intersects with Montreal St.
