1. Introduction

The Town of Goderich Recreation Department invites proposals for the supply and delivery of a new 2026/2027 Ice Resurfacers.

2. Proposal Requirements

Equipment Description and Technical Specifications

- Manufacturer, make, model, model year, and country of manufacture
- Complete product literature and technical specifications
- Information on overall dimensions, turning radius, operating weight, and ice-resurfacing capacity
- Engine or electric powertrain, fuel type or battery system, and expected operating duration
- Water tank capacity, snow tank capacity, and flooding capability
- Ice-cutting, washing, conditioning, and water-dispensing systems
- Blade type and blade adjustment features
- Operator controls
- Standard equipment, accessories, and optional equipment

Pricing

- Pricing must include all costs associated with supply, delivery, unloading, pre-delivery inspection, commissioning, operator training, manuals, and warranty
- Separate pricing for all optional equipment, accessories, extended warranties, service packages if applicable

Warranty and Service Support

- Full manufacturer warranty details, including duration, coverage, exclusions, and deductible requirements, if any
- Details of available extended warranty options
- Location of the authorized service provider(s) supporting the proposed unit
- Description of service response times, emergency service availability, parts availability, and anticipated parts lead times
- Confirmation of availability of replacement or loaner equipment during extended repairs, if offered

3. Instructions to Proponents

Proponents are encouraged to submit all available equipment options with a demonstrated record of reliable and successful operation within the recreation ice-resurfacing industry.

4. Evaluation Criteria

- Equipment suitability and technical specifications — 45%
- Price and evaluated cost — 35%
- Warranty, service and parts support — 15%
- Delivery and training — 5%

5. General Terms and Conditions

The Town of Goderich reserves the right to accept or reject any proposals and to waive irregularities at its own discretion. The Town will not necessarily accept the lowest bid and reserves the right to negotiate terms with the successful provider. Should the Town not receive any submission satisfactory to the Town of Goderich in its sole and absolute discretion, the Town reserves the right to re-tender.
