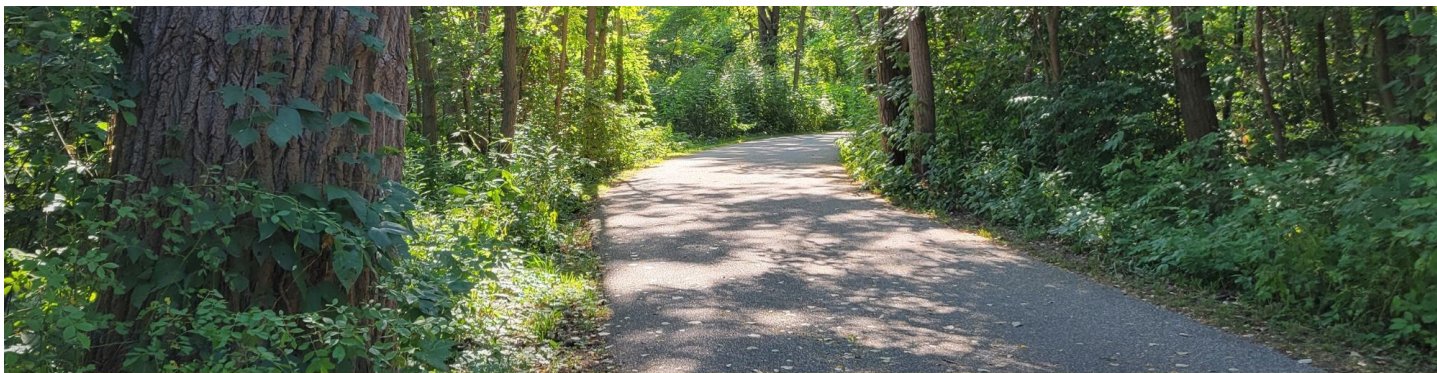




Mayor's Message
