Canadian War Museum Exhibition Comes to LaSalle

Fighting in Flanders | Gas. Mud. Memory.

An important chapter of Canadian history comes to the community this fall with a travelling exhibition by the Canadian War Museum at the LaSalle Civic Centre from Tuesday, September 8 to Saturday, November 14. Admission is free.

The exhibition highlights Canada's significant role in Belgium during the First World War and offers visitors a powerful look at the experiences of Canadian soldiers on the front lines. Through a series of four engaging panels featuring historic photographs, personal testimonials, and artwork, visitors will gain a deeper understanding of the challenges and sacrifices Canadians faced overseas.

Public Works News

Malden Road Project Update Major Construction Scheduled for Spring 2027

Work continues on Malden Road as utility companies' complete infrastructure upgrades ahead of future road improvements. Cahill Drain Bridge upgrades and watermain work are expected to begin this September, and the full project is expected to be completed by the end of 2027.

Throughout the utility, bridge, and watermain construction, residents and motorists should anticipate intermittent lane closures. One lane of

traffic will remain open in each direction to help maintain traffic flow.

Looking ahead, the larger Malden Road improvements project will be tendered with construction anticipated to begin in spring 2027. The project includes the installation of new storm sewers, widening Malden Road to add a centre turning lane and the addition of walking and cycling paths on both sides of the road. Plans also include a new traffic light at Reaume Road and two pedestrian crossovers along Malden Road. Project updates and traffic impacts will be shared as the work progresses.
