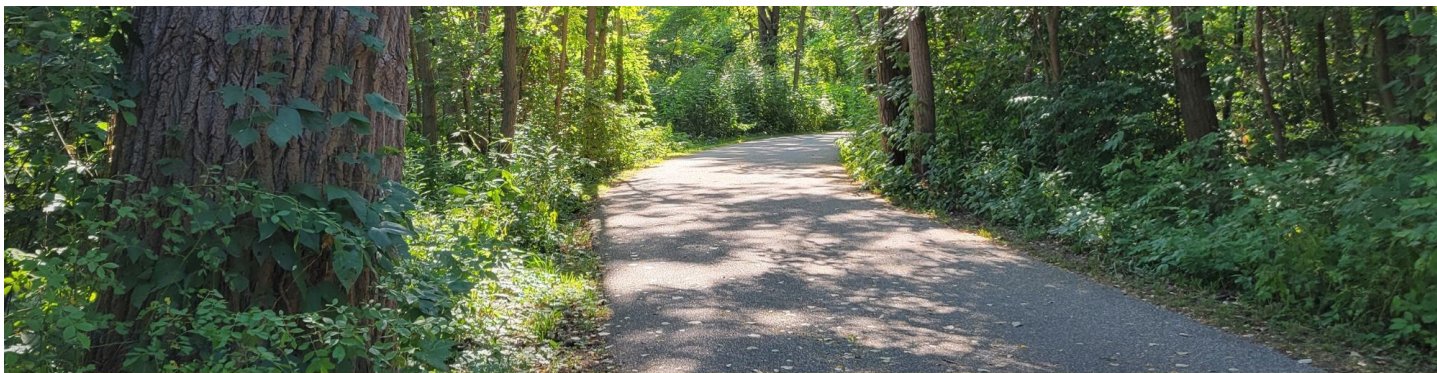




Mayor's Message

Hello residents of LaSalle,

I am happy to share that the storm sewer reconstruction project on Front Road is expected to finish soon. Over the next couple of weeks, crews will be completing the remaining asphalt paving, line painting, and restoration work. To ensure the safety of both workers and motorists, the northbound lane will remain closed while restoration activities are underway. Once roadway work is complete, the project will move into the next phase, which involves the construction of two new pump stations.
