Cold capping

Scalp cooling, also known as cold capping, can help reduce and manage hair loss caused by chemotherapy treatments. A cap, which comes in two sections (an inner cap and an outer cover), is worn for a short time before, during, and after each of your chemotherapy treatments. The cap is attached to a system, which circulates a coolant liquid around the inner cap, reducing the temperature of your scalp. Reducing the temperature of your scalp may help to protect your hair follicles and reduce the damage caused by chemotherapy medications. It may allow you to keep enough of your hair to avoid wearing a wig. Cold capping can cause headaches. You can find more information about cold capping on the following websites:
