

**CITY OF PETERBOROUGH
FLOOD REDUCTION SUBSIDY PROGRAM**

Are you Protected??

The City of Peterborough is offering a subsidy program to assist property owners with the complete foundation drain disconnection from the sanitary service, installation of a Backwater Valve, and/or a Sump Pit and Pump.

There are three ways to be eligible:

- 1) Provide proof of loss from the **2002, 2004 or March 2012** flood event; or
- 2) The property is located in **"a priority area"** as defined by the City of Peterborough Flood Reduction Subsidy Committee, (the committee); or
- 3) The installation of a **Backwater Valve** or a **Sump Pit and Pump**, which has resulted in the **foundation drain being disconnected** from the sanitary sewer.

The extent of the subsidy will cover the following:

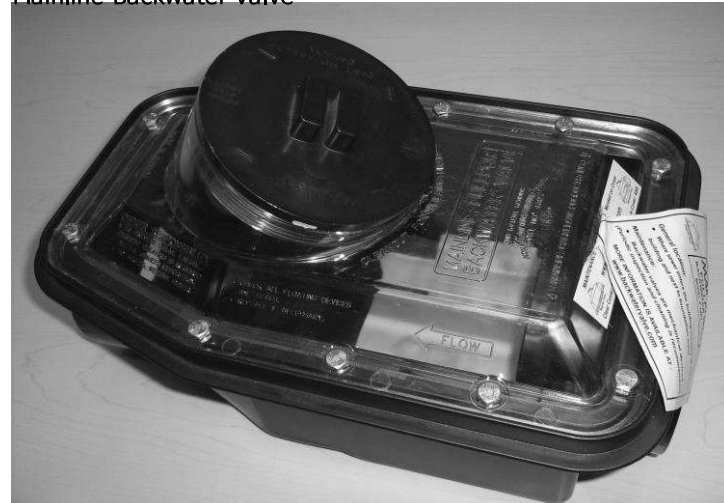
~Backwater valve installation to a maximum of \$1,000.00.
~Sump Pit & Pump to isolate drainage/storm leads to a maximum of \$1,500.00. **Note:** The foundation drain to be disconnected from the sanitary service.
~Both Backwater Valve & Sump Pit & Pump (as above) with the disconnection, to a maximum of \$3,000.00.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ~The issuance of a Building Permit.
- ~A successful final inspection.
- ~Submission of full and complete invoices for eligible costs, with proof of payment of all submitted invoices.
- ~The installation must be undertaken by a qualified installer.

Applications approved will be on a first come first served basis, due to funding limitations. Eligible applications that were accepted or appeals that were awarded are not guaranteed to receive subsidy in the event of program termination or complete expenditure of funding.

Mainline Backwater Valve

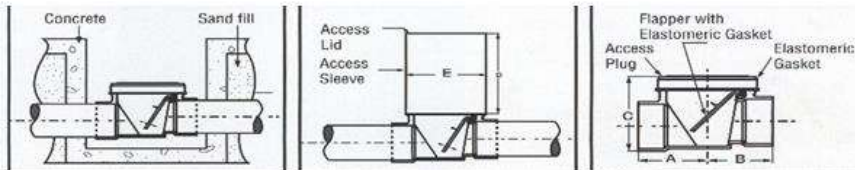
