



Madill & St. Michael's – Availability Adult graves, Columbarium Niches

233 Old Muskoka Rd Huntsville

Adult Grave 3.5'x10' Single Grave Capacity: One Full Burial Four Cremated Remains

Columbarium Niche D:14" x H:14" x W:12.5" Niche Capacity: Two Cremated Remains

Madill Cemetery was donated by John Madill in 1873. It is pictured in the book Old Canadian Cemeteries: Places of Memory because of its historical significance as a pioneer settlement. The Madill Church Preservation Society is in care of the Square Timber Church situated within the cemetery. The earliest Burial was in 1873.

Hutcheson Memorial is the Town of Huntsville's primary cemetery. It was established in 1936 as a land donation from the W. E. Hutcheson Family. A small Chapel was later built on the property in 1938 to hold funeral services. This cemetery features columbarium with seating and surrounding gardens. Poppies have been incorporated within the gardens to honor our veterans.

Locks Cemetery – Availability Cremation Graves

2'x4' Cremation Grave Capacity: Two Cremated Remains

The Locks Cemetery is located on Brunel Road in close proximity to the scenic Brunel Locks. It has unique rolling hills, nestled into The Muskoka River. This Cemetery was one of the first resting places for many early settlers of the area.

Ilfracombe – Availability Adult Graves

3921 Ravenscliffe Rd. Ilfracombe

5'x10' Single Grave Capacity: One Full Burial Six Cremated Remains

Ilfracombe Cemetery, quiet and nestled at the end of Ravenscliffe Road in close proximity to Buck Lake. There is a beautiful and historic stone church located past the cemetery and a must see for the area.

Stephenson - Availability Adult Graves

280 Muskoka District Road 10 Port Sydney

Adult Grave 4'x9' Single Grave Capacity: One Full Burial Four Cremated Remains

Stephenson Memorial Cemetery opened in 1877 after a land purchase from the R. D. Brown Family. It is visible upon entering the deeply rooted lakeside community of Port Sydney. This cemetery is seen as a landscape of charming contours and old characteristic feature trees.
