Tax Installment Due Dates are August 31 and October 30, 2026

Landfill Punch Cards, Aug 2026-July 2027

Landfill Punch Cards for household waste are sent to ratepayers who have dwellings on their property. Landfill punch cards should be included with your property tax bill or are mailed to ratepayers who receive online tax bills. If you are eligible to receive a punch card but do not have them by the end of August, please call the office and let us know.

Following the transition of voters' list management from MPAC to Elections Ontario, some non-resident electors may not have been carried over.

Be FIRESMART!

Wildfire risk is increasing across Canada, and most homes that burn—about 90%—are ignited by airborne embers. These embers can travel kilometres ahead of a fire and ignite materials on or near your home.

The good news is that by stopping those sparks from taking hold, you can significantly improve your chances of protecting your property. It starts right where you live. Homes and the areas around them—known as the Home Ignition Zone—are especially vulnerable.

FireSmart principles focus on simple, practical steps you can take in this zone to reduce risk. This fire season, take action to prevent ignition and slow the spread of wildfires.
