REGARDING PROPOSED BYLAW NO. 2026-29

Bylaw No. 2026-29 proposes broad amendments to the Cornerstone Area Structure Plan. Changes include an updated Land Use Concept with more mixed-use and medium- to high-density residential development, as well as expanding the area of the plan to include some land south of Highway 27 that is not currently part of an Area Structure Plan. A public hearing regarding the proposed bylaw will be held on **Tuesday, October 13, 2026, at 1:00 PM** in the Council Chambers at the Olds Municipal Centre.

Note this sale is for the designated manufactured home only, it does not include the lot on which it currently sits. Any purchaser will need to either make arrangements to have the designated manufactured home moved to another location or negotiate a lease of the lot with the mobile home park. The purchaser is also responsible for obtaining vacant possession, if required.

Terms: Cash or certified cheque payable to the Town of Olds, non-refundable deposit of 10% of the successful bid at the time of sale with balance of 90% of bid due within 30 days.
