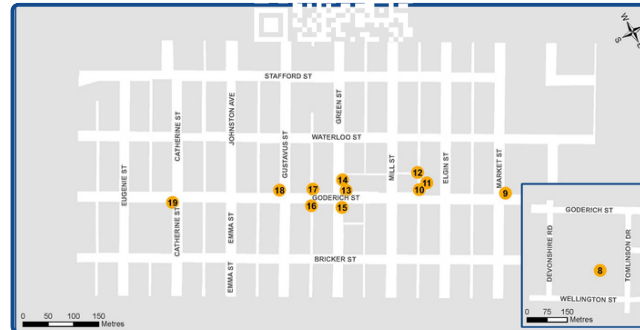
Through public art, we celebrate diverse perspectives, honour local heritage, recognize Indigenous culture and knowledge, and create gathering places where residents and visitors can connect.
