Help Conserve Water – Use Rain Barrels!

Rain barrels collect and store rainwater from your roof, which can then be used for gardens, plants, and outdoor cleaning – without drawing from the municipal water system.

By using a rain barrel, you can:

- Reduce your household water use
- Keep your garden healthy during dry conditions
- Help ease pressure on local water infrastructure
