



Consent to Provide Candidate Contact Information

Notice to Candidates:

After a candidate files a Nomination Paper, the news media and public frequently wish to contact him or her. The information contained in a Nomination Paper is deemed to be a public record according to section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act and may be inspected by any person at the Clerk's Office at a time when the office is open. However, the media and members of the public often do not wish to take the time to go to the office to view the information. They would prefer instead to be able to obtain contact information by telephone or via e-mail.

A candidate wishing to establish a campaign profile may find such contact to be of assistance. Therefore, to make this initial contact easier, a candidate may wish to authorize the Clerk's Office staff to release address, telephone or e-mail contact information as provided on their Nomination Paper. This form is to be completed by the candidate and returned to the Clerk's Office. Please note that there is no obligation on the part of a candidate to authorize the release of their contact information.

I have read the above explanation with respect to the limitations which exist about the release of contact information. Having considered the information, I hereby provide the following directions to the Clerk's Office staff (please place a mark in the appropriate box or boxes).
