

The Town of Shelburne: Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee - Black History Month Quiz and Contest

Shelburne Contest Rules – Black History Month Contest

1. Eligibility: The Shelburne Black History Month Contest is open to residents of the Town of Shelburne Ontario Canada who enter the Black History Month Quiz, on the Town of Shelburne's website.

Entrants must be 13 years of age or older as of their date of entry in this promotion to qualify. This contest is subject to Federal and Provincial laws and regulations.

2. Town of Shelburne employees, its subsidiaries, affiliates, suppliers, partners, directors and councilors (collectively the "Employees"), as well as members of an Employees' immediate family and/or those living in the same household of Employees, are ineligible to participate in the Shelburne Black History Month Contest.

3. Sponsorship: The sponsor is the Shelburne Diversity and Inclusion Committee, a committee of the Town of Shelburne, located at 203 Main Street East Shelburne Ontario L9V3K7.

4. Official Rules:

Agreement to Rules: By entering this Contest, the Entrant ("You") agrees to:

b. How to Enter: Eligible entrants can enter The Shelburne Black History Month Contest by submitting a quiz online on the Town of Shelburne website.

As a participant, your entry must fully meet all Contest requirements, as specified in the Official Rules, to be eligible to win the prize. Entries that do not adhere to the Official Rules or specifications will be disqualified at the Sponsor's sole discretion.

c. Fraudulent methods of entry or circumvention of the rules may result in the Sponsor invalidating your entries and removing them from the Contest at the Sponsor's sole discretion.

6. Prizes: The Winner of the Shelburne's Black History Month Contest will receive one of 4 \$25 gift cards from a Local registered business of their (your) choice. There shall be no cash or other prize substitution permitted except at the Sponsor's discretion. The prize is non-transferable. a. The Winner shall not transfer assignment of the prize to others, nor shall the Winner request the cash equivalent or prize substitution. By accepting the prize, the selected Winner grants permission for the Sponsor to use the Winner's likeness, entry, and name for purposes of advertising, without further compensation unless prohibited by law.

b. The Business must be registered with the Town of Shelburne. The Town requires all businesses located within Town limits to be registered with the Corporation of the Town of Shelburne

7. Odds: The total number of eligible entries received determines the odds of winning.

8. Selection and Notification of Winner: The Winner will be selected randomly by draw under the supervision of the Sponsor.

a. The Sponsor will notify the Winner by contacting them through by email within 5 business days following the Winner selection.

b. The Sponsor is not responsible for nor shall have no liability for Winner's failure to receive notices due to security settings that may cause notifications to be marked as spam or junk. Nor shall the Sponsor be liable for the Winner's provision of incorrect or otherwise non-functioning contact information.
