Notice of advance voter registration deadline for the District of Sooke:

Advance Voter registration is not required for the District of Sooke 2026 election, but it can make your voting experience faster. The District of Sooke uses the BC Provincial voter list. You can register in advance directly with Elections BC at <https://elections.bc.ca> until August 18th, 2026. You can register at the District of Sooke offices using a hard copy form available at reception during regular office hours until August 25th, 2026. Eligible voters who have not registered in advance can register at the time of voting with two documents that provide evidence of identity, at least one of which contains a signature.

Notice of List of registered electors

A copy of the list of registered electors is available for public inspection at the Sooke District Offices (2205 Otter Point Road, Sooke) during regular office hours from September 1st, 2026 until October 17th, 2026. An elector may request that their personal information be omitted or obscured from the list, and any objection to the registration of a person as an elector may be made before 4pm on September 11th, 2026, by emailing elections@sooke.ca, writing to the District of Sooke at 2205 Otter Point Road, V9Z 1J2, or speaking to an Election Officer at the District of Sooke Offices.

Nominations to fill the roles of Mayor and Council of the District of Sooke will be received by the Chief Election Officer or the Deputy Chief Election Officer no earlier than 9am on September 1st, 2026, and no later than 4pm on September 11th, 2026.

Nominations may be made by returning the completed nomination forms in-person at the District of Sooke Offices at 2205 Otter Point Road, Sooke, BC, V9Z 1J2 during normal office hours within this time. Alternatively, completed nomination forms may be returned by email to elections@sooke.ca, or faxed to 250-642-0541 within this time.

More information about the requirements and procedures for making a nomination, as well as Nomination packages themselves, can be collected in hard copy from the District of Sooke office reception during normal opening hours from August 14th, 2026, to September 11th, 2026, or downloaded during the same time from www.sooke.ca/elections.
