Glengarry Memorial Hospital Foundation Presents CT Scanner Campaign to Council

The Glengarry Memorial Hospital Foundation shared an update on its campaign to bring a CT scanner to Hôpital Glengarry Memorial Hospital.

Many South Glengarry residents rely on HGMH for emergency care, diagnostic imaging, laboratory testing and specialist appointments. Adding a CT scanner would allow approximately 6,000 patients each year to receive important testing closer to home, helping doctors make faster diagnoses and treatment decisions.

The campaign has raised \$2 million toward its \$3.5-million goal. The remaining funds will help purchase the scanner and cover installation and training costs.
