Re: Election Advisory #5: Election Signs

Commencing August 22, 2026, Election Signs can be placed in the Municipality in accordance with [Election Sign By-law 2026-019](#). Any Election Sign erected must be removed no later than October 30, 2026 (unless otherwise removed in accordance with the By-law).

As this By-law is new (as compared to the last Municipal Election), I encourage all Candidates to carefully review the terms and requirements of the new By-law. I ask Candidates to review in particular the provisions of sections 3 to 5 of this By-law which detail the locations and restrictions on Election Signs and their placement thereof.

Please note, any Election Sign in violation of this By-law may be removed without notice.

Further, any violations of this By-law may result in Administrative Monetary Penalties being assessed against the Candidate. I have linked for you [here](#) the potential monetary penalty charges that could be assessed for violations of Election Sign By-law 2026-019.

In particular, I remind all Candidates who wish to use/erect Election Signs will need to first apply for and obtain an Election Sign Permit. You may access the application [here](#) or via the Town's [Election website](#).

Please note, any Election Sign erected without a Permit will be immediately removed and may be subject to monetary penalty charges.
